## 4U Hunter's Checklist

Please send to us PRIOR to arrival:

- Signed copy of 4U Outfitters Cancellation Policy (must be done before your hunt is considered a solid booking!)
- Paid balance on hunt (30 days prior to arrival)
- Copy of hunting license
- Hunter questionnaire
- Signed acknowledgement of risks
- Hunter's Safety (required if you were born on or after Jan 1, 1966)

After arrival: (we will take you to get these items)

- Conservation Stamp
- Elk Management Stamp

## 4U Outfitters Equipment Suggestions

**Clothing:** The weather you will experience can range from the balmy fall days, to winter type conditions. We recommend layered clothing, particularly for the upper body. A good waterproof over covering for both upper and lower body is a must! The QUIETER type of outer clothing you have, the better. There are several types of quiet, breathable, waterproof outerwear clothing with today's technology. **Footgear** is also very important. You may encounter all types of conditions (rain, snow, mud, dry). Remember, for all clothing/footgear, DRY is Warm!!

**Duffle:** Your equipment, less your rifle, **has** to fit into one duffle bag. Your Duffle bag can be no more than 36" long and 18-20" wide. **Or, 2 smaller duffels will actually pack better.** We recommend a bag with a zipper running the full

length of the bag. If the bag is not waterproof, line it with a large, heavy duty trash bag. When fully packed, your duffle bag(s) **cannot** weigh over 65 lbs. If your duffel bag(s) weighs more than 65 lbs., **we will** adjust it prior to loading it on our pack animals. Any duffle bags larger or heavier than the above requirements results in difficulty for packing and overloading our pack animals. **All** of the equipment you will need **can easily** be packed following the above requirements. **We furnish** large, comfortable sleeping bags for you with a polar fleece liner. The liners are changed prior to each hunt. A comfortable sleeping pad and cot are also furnished. We provide a saddle scabbard for your rifle, an saddlebags will be on your saddle. Saddlebags are only for your lunch and light items such as gloves, camera, film, flashlight, etc. (maximum weight in saddle bags is 5 lbs/side). We respect the fact that your equipment represents a big investment and we train our crew to handle it as carefully as possible. It is unlikely that you will experience any problems, but due to many variables in a wilderness environment, we **cannot** guarantee against damage or loss. You may want to check your insurance coverage.

Please make sure to make arrangements to adequately transport your meat back home. Coolers, boxes, etc. can be purchased locally (in Jackson) if you do not wish to bring them with you. Dry ice is also available. We will transport your game to the processor for you (in Jackson). Processing, payment and shipping are your responsibility. We can also recommend a very good taxidermist for your trophy needs.

**Rifle & Optics:** We recommend a rifle that delivers a high velocity, flat trajectory, and one that you are **comfortable** and **competent** shooting. Sight in your rifle! Familiarize yourself with how you and the rifle perform from 50-350 yards. We recommend a partition type bullet that will give good, controlled expansion as well as deep penetration. A quality scope, such as Leupold, Shepherd, Swarovski, Weaver, Redfield or Burris, will give you minimal problems due to fogging, adjustments and impact of shock damage. A good rifle sling is a must for the type of terrain that you will be hunting. Saddle scabbards will be used to carry your rifle to camp and while hunting.

**Bear Country:** You will be hunting where there are GRIZZLY BEARS! Instead of carrying a handgun for protection, we strongly urge all our hunters to carry PEPPER SPRAY, specifically one that is rated for Grizzly Bears!! Pepper spray works! We have used the brand UDAP, and have not had it fail us. Make sure you only buy the 10% Oleoresin Capsicum pepper spray. We use the 9-oz size, belt model. You are more likely to save yourself in a defensive situation with a Grizzly Bear using pepper spray rather than a firearm. You do not have to be nearly as accurate with pepper spray, and buy using it, no one else has to be

permanently harmed (yourself, a bear or other humans). Call if you have any questions regarding this suggestion!

Equipment and Clothing Check List:

Items to go in your saddlebags or on your person, therefore should not be packed in your duffle bag:

Hunting License	Gloves
Elk Management and Conservation Stamps(to be attached to your hunting license) <b>Hunter's Safety Cert. if applicable (depending on D.O.B)</b>	Headlamp and Flashlight with extra batteries for both
Sunglasses	Matches
Pepper Spray and Holster	Waterproof Coat/Pants
Hunting Knife	Camera/Film

The items listed below are in addition to what you wear and carry on your horse for your ride into camp.

**NO duffel bag will be packed into camp weighing over 65 lbs.!**

20 rounds of ammunition	4 large game - game bags****
2 medium weight shirts	2 heavy weight shirts
2 prs jeans or hunting pants	2 changes of long underwear
4 changes of underwear	Extra film
4 pr heavy weight socks	1 pr felt lined packs
4 pr medium weight socks	1 pr camp shoes (light & comfortable)
6 pr light weight socks	Personal Medications
1 pr medium warmth boots (broke in)	1 towel/wash cloth
Shaving kit & toiletry items	1 pair binoculars (optional)
1 hunter orange piece of clothing (can be vest, hat or coat) <b>a hat is preferred!</b>	

\*\*\*\*These game bags are very important. We quarter out your game animal at the harvest site, then use the bags to transport your game meat to camp, then to be processed. These bags help us to mark your game and keep it clean.

**Note: Non-prescription or illegal drugs are not permitted in camp, NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!**

Clothing Requirement – During rifle seasons, you must wear one or more exterior garment of fluorescent orange above the waist.

Hunter's Safety Requirements – Any hunter born on or after **January 1, 1966**, must possess and have on his person while hunting, a Hunter's Safety Certificate (issued from any state). **ALL** Teton Park hunts require Hunter Safety Certificate regardless of age.

We assume you have read and will follow all these suggestions and requirements. Feel free to call us with any questions.

My participation in this activity is purely voluntary, no one is forcing me to participate, and I elect to participate in spite of and with full knowledge of the inherent risks.

I acknowledge that engaging in this activity may require a degree of skill and knowledge different than other activities and that I have responsibilities as a participant. I acknowledge that the staff of 4U Outfitters has been available to more fully explain to me the nature and physical demands of this activity and the inherent risks, hazards, and dangers associated with this activity.

I certify that I am fully capable of participating in this activity. Therefore, I assume and accept full responsibility for myself, including all minor children in my care, custody, and control, for bodily injury, death or loss of personal property and expenses as a result of those inherent risks and dangers identified herein and those inherent risks and dangers not specifically identified, and, as a result of my negligence in participating in this activity.
